TENDER NOTICE AND INVITATION TO TENDER

The UMSOBOMVU MUNICIPALITY invites tenderers from civil engineering contractors for the **Upgrading of the Norvalspont Bulk Water Supply**.

The works will include the construction of a new raw water abstraction point; a galvanised steel rising main on concrete plinths connected to a new uPVC rising main to the water treatment facilities in Norvalspont; associated new pumps and telemetry; upgrading of the existing water treatment works including a new elevated tank; upgrading of tanks, concrete works and pump stations.

It is estimated that tenderers should have a CIDB contractor grading designation of **6 CE** or higher, and a Mechanical Electrical Sub-contractor of **3 ME** or higher. Contractors registered as potentially emerging (**5CE PE**) enterprises with the CIDB who are registered in one contractor grading designation lower than that required in terms of the total sum tendered are eligible to tender. No exceptional assistance will be provided to any potentially emerging contractor by the Umsobomvu Municipality and all standard contractual requirements have to be met in order for such a contractor to be appointed.

Only tenderers who satisfy the eligibility criteria stated in the Tender Conditions and Tender Data are eligible to submit tenders.

The Umsobomvu Municipality Procurement and Supply Chain Management Policies, the Preferential Procurement Policy framework Act, Act No 5 of 2000 and the regulations promulgated under this act shall apply in the adjudication and awarding of the tender.

Tender documents may be collected during working hours after 08:00 as from **4 March 2015**. Tender documents will not be available at the site inspection meeting in Norvalspont and all documents must be purchased prior to the meeting.

A non-refundable tender deposit of R 300.00 payable in cash only is required on collection of the tender documents.

A compulsory site inspection meeting with representatives of the Employer will take place at the Club House in **Main Street, Norvalspont** on **11 March 2015** starting at **10:00 am**. Persons arriving later than **10:15** will not be allowed into the meeting. Please confirm attendance in writing to pieter.venter@worleyparsons.com by end of business on Monday 9 March 2015. Only tenderers who attend the compulsory site inspection meeting are eligible to submit tenders. The closing time for receipts of tender is **12:00** on Friday, **20 March 2015**. Sealed tenders, endorsed with the corresponding tender number and description, must be placed in the tender box in the foyer of Umsobomvu Municipality, **21A Church Street, Colesberg**.

The following tender conditions but not limited to, are also included in the tender documents:

- The tender offer validity period is 90 days.
- Bidders must submit a certificate certifying that the bidder has no undisputed commitments for municipal services towards a municipality or service provider i.r.o. payments which is overdue more than 30 days.
- Audited financial statements must be submitted with the bid covering at least three previous financial years (if the tendered amount exceeds R10 million including VAT)
- The Bidder must supply any particulars of contracts awarded by an organ of state for the past 5 years including particulars of any material non-compliance or disputes concerning the execution of such a contract.
- Statement of goods or services sourced from outside the RSA, and if so what portion and whether any portion of payment from the municipality is expected to be transferred out of the Republic.
- An original current SARS Tax Clearance Certificate in respect of Income and VAT must be attached to the bids.
- Bidders must have certified evidence of BBBEE status issued by SANAS, IRBA or SANAS accredited agents.
- The bid will be adjudicated on the following criteria: Price = 90 points. BBBEE contribution level = 10 points.
