- 3. Bidders must submit a certificate certifying that the bidder has no undisputed commitments for municipal services towards a municipality or service provider i.r.o. payments which is overdue more than 30 days.
- 4. The bidder must supply any particulars of similar contracts awarded by an organ of state for the past 3 years including particulars of any material non-compliance or disputes concerning the execution of such a contract.
- 5. Statement of goods or services sourced from outside the RSA, and if so what portion and whether any portion of payment from the municipality is expected to be transferred out of the Republic.
- 6. The Umsobomvu Procurement and Supply Chain Management Policies, the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No. 5 of 2000 and the regulations promulgated under this Act shall apply in the evaluation and awarding of the bid.
