Post Requirements

The candidate should hold as a minimum, a three-year Bachelor's degree or a three year National Diploma with majors in Accounting, Economic or Finance including either Risk Management and/or Auditing, amongst other. The appointed intern will sign an internship agreement which is in addition to the employment contract. The effect of the agreement is to ensure commitment to the programme which require, amongst other, full participation in the educational and workplace assignments and observance of policies and procedures.
