Umsobomvu Municipality hereby invites suitably qualifying construction companies to submit quotations for the "**Errection of Height Restriction Elements**". The height restrictions are to be erected at positions that will be indicated during the site briefing. Sealed Quotations clearly marked "**HEIGHT RESTRICTION ELEMENTS**" must be submitted to the Umsobomvu Municipality 21A Church Street, COLESBERG. Postal delivery to reach Umsobomvu Municipality, Private Bag X6, COLESBERG, 9795, not later than **Friday the 11th of May 2016**.

Scope Of Work Includes :

- ✚ Reinforced concrete column bases with the strength of 30 Mpa.
- ✚ Manufacturing of 203*203*46kg/m steel columns and beams using O₂ butt welding.
- ✚ The use of epoxy grouted dowels to hold the concrete bases to be used.

A non-refundable deposit of **R 50** payable in cash or by bank guaranteed cheque made out in favour of the employer is required on collection of the document.

A non-compulsory briefing meeting by the representatives of the Employer will take place at the municipal offices of **Umsobomvu Municipality** at 21A Church Street Colesberg on **Friday, 22nd April 2016** starting at **11:00**. Only prospective contractors who attend the compulsory briefing meeting are eligible to submit their tender.

The closing time for receipts of tenders is **12:00, Friday, 11th May 2016**. Sealed quotations, endorsed with the corresponding notice number and description, **REQUEST FOR QUOTATIONS TO ERRECT HEIGHT RESTRICTION ELEMENTS: TENDER No. 02/04/2016**, must be placed in the tender box at the office of Umsobomvu Municipality in Colesberg. Postal delivery to reach Umsobomvu Municipality, Private Bag X6, Colesberg, 9795, not later than **12:00 on Friday, 11th May 2016**, after which the proposals will be opened in public. Telegraphic, telephonic, telex, facsimile, e-mailed and late tenders will not be accepted.

This tender will be evaluated on the 80/20 points system where 80 points represents price and 20 points represents B-BBEE status level contribution.

The Umsobomvu Procurement and Supply Chain Management Policies, the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No. 5 of 2000 and the regulations promulgated under this Act shall apply in the evaluation and awarding of the tender. Interested tenderers who wish to claim preferential points must attach to their tender certified evidence of B-BBEE status level issued by a registered verification agency.

Declaration of Interest forms are available on the web-site (www.umsobomvumun.co.za) which must be filled out and submitted with the tender.

1. Tenderers must supply with their tender a valid Tax Clearance certificate and proof of similar work done.
2. All tenders should hold good for 90 days from closing date.
3. Tenderers must submit a certificate certifying that the tenderer has no undisputed commitments for municipal services towards a municipality or service provider i.r.o. payments which is overdue more than 30 days.
4. Statement of goods or services sourced from outside the RSA, and if so what portion and whether any portion of payment from the municipality is expected to be transferred out of the Republic.
5. Tenderers must have certified evidence of BBBEE status issued by SANAS, IRBA or SANAS accredited agents.

The Municipality does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any quotations. The quotation is subject to the General Conditions of Contract and/or Special Conditions of Contract.

Requirements for sealing, addressing, delivery, opening and assessment of quotation are stated in the advert.
